 - a) To live a life consistent with the gospel and worthy of our high calling in the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - b) To spend some time each day in prayer and reading the Scriptures in order to maintain a close personal relationship with God.
 - c) Unless unavoidably prevented, to share in Grosvenor's corporate worship on Sundays and to be regular and faithful in the observance of the Lord's Supper. (Members who stop attending, may be removed after 6 months.)
 - d) To fulfil the ministry of intercession both privately and by being present, whenever possible, at the meetings for corporate prayer.
 - e) To be committed and loving in relationship with all the members of Grosvenor.
 - f) To serve the Lord Jesus Christ in Grosvenor according to the needs of the church and my gifts.
 - g) To accept personal responsibility for the government of Grosvenor as a local church by being present, whenever possible, at the church meetings.
 - h) To give regularly to Grosvenor in order to support the work of the Lord in & through the church (for example, by standing order through the bank).
 - To witness to the Lord Jesus Christ by word and deed as part of the worldwide church's evangelisation of the world, and to try to bring others to Grosvenor in order to hear the good news of our Lord Jesus Christ.

BASIS OF FAITH

- I. The plenary inspiration, sole and all sufficiency of the Holy Scriptures.
- 2. The Trinity in unity of the Godhead.
- 3. The essential Deity and perfect humanity of our Saviour.
- 4. The personality of the Holy Spirit.
- 5. The depraved and fallen state of man through sin.
- 6. The justification of the sinner through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 7. The atonement through the substitutionary death, sacrifice and blood shedding of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 8. The personality of the Devil.
- 9. The resurrection of the body.
- 10. The immortality of the soul.
- 11. The everlasting security of the believer.
- 12. The everlasting punishment of those who die impenitent, according to the words of Scripture: "He that believes on the Son has everlasting life and he that believes not the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."
- 13. The perpetuity of the ordinance of baptism that is, believers immersion in water on the confession by each individual of faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 14. The perpetuity of the ordinance of the Lord's Supper on the first day of week, thereby showing forth, in the simple emblems of the broken bread and poured out wine, the Lord's death "till he come".
- 15. The priesthood of all believers.
- 16. The obligation resting upon all saved souls to "live soberly, righteously and godly in this present world."

STATEMENT OF BELIEFS

New **Statement of Beliefs** adopted in 2004 to replace the Basis of Faith above – but awaiting formal ratification once the new trust deed has been approved by the Charity Commissioners

We believe:

- 1. In one triune God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, as revealed in Scripture, and in His sovereignty and grace in creation, providence, revelation, redemption and final judgement.
- 2. In the divine inspiration and consequent inerrancy of Scripture as originally given, and in its final authority in, and all-sufficiency for, all matters of faith and conduct.
- 3. In the universal sinfulness and guilt of the human race in consequence of the Fall, and in our liability to God's wrath and judgement.
- 4. In the real and personal existence of the devil.
- 5. In Jesus Christ, the divine and eternally pre-existent Son of God, who took upon Himself true humanness, was born of a virgin, and is the sole mediator between human beings and God.
- 6. In Jesus Christ's perfect life and sacrificial death as our representative and substitute, whose life and death are the sole and all-sufficient ground of redemption from the guilt and power of sin, and from its eternal consequences.
- 7. In the bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, in His ascension into heaven, His present reign, and His personal, visible and imminent return in power and glory
- 8. In the justification of the sinner solely by the grace of God through faith alone, resulting in the eternal security of the believer and in works that please God.
- 9. In the person of God the Holy Spirit and in His illuminating, convicting, regenerating, indwelling, sanctifying and empowering work in every believer.
- 10. In the priesthood of all believers, their calling to serve God with the gifts He has given them, their equal standing before God and their equal access to the Father through the Son by the Spirit.
- 11. In one universal Church, comprising all believers from all nations of all time, as the body of which Christ is the Head, expressed locally in terms of churches committed to the Word of God and prayer, mutual service and care, and mission.
- 12. In baptism of believers in the Lord Jesus Christ in obedience to His command, and in the Lord's Supper as a symbolic remembrance of His death.
- 13. In the resurrection of the body and the future, final judgement, subsequent to which those who reject the Lord Jesus Christ will suffer eternal punishment, while believers will enjoy and serve God and His Christ perfectly in the new creation for all eternity.
